**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
THE HUMMINGBIRD FAMILY RESOURCE
CENTER, INC.**

**A CALIFORNIA PUBLIC BENEFIT
CORPORATION**

ARTICLE ONE: The name of this corporation is The Hummingbird Family Resource Center, Inc.

ARTICLE TWO: This corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable purposes. The specific purpose for which this corporation is organized is to support charitable and educational services for the well-being of the general public and the communities of Southeast Inyo County, California.

ARTICLE THREE: The name and address in the State of California of this corporation's initial agent for service of process is Jennifer O. Viereck (Secretary), 320 Downey Street, Tecopa CA 92389.

ARTICLE FOUR: (a) This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

(b) Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (1) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or (2) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code.

(c) No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE FIVE: The names and addresses of the persons appointed to act as the initial Board Members of this corporation are:

ARTICLE SIX: The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes and no part of the net income or assets of the organization shall ever inure to the benefit of any Board Member, officer or member thereof or to the benefit of any private person.

On the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment of, or provision for payment of, all debts and liabilities of this corporation, shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes and which has established its tax-exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE SEVEN: The name of the existing unincorporated association, now being incorporated by the filing of these Articles of Incorporation, is Southeast Inyo Children’s Council.

ARTICLE EIGHT: The Southeast Inyo Children’s Council will continue to function as a discreet entity, an advisory committee to the Board of Directors for the coordination of all social services in our service area. As the Board is developed to its full capacity, individual founding members may choose to withdraw, serving only in their capacity on the Southeast Inyo Children’s Council Advisory Committee.
