TBAG Policies

The Tecopa Basin Artist Group (TBAG) operates a co-op art gallery at the historic Tecopa Hot Springs Resort. Hours are from 10:00 am to 4:00 pm. We collectively share the responsibilities of staffing, putting up and taking down shows, providing refreshments for receptions, handling public service announcements, advertising, maintaining a webpage and general administration. We always keep these commitments, unless we have explicitly arranged for a substitute and notified all parties involved.

Members, Associate and Guest Artists. All art is juried by the full TBAG group, both for membership purposes and for each individual show. Art work must qualify as fine art and not 'craft', and artists should feel a real bond with the California desert area. For prospective members, associates or guest artists, the TBAG group will schedule a meeting prior to any event to discuss and review their work. After a final closed session for members only, a decision will be shared with the artist. We welcome requests for membership, and encourage you to stop by any gallery events and share your thoughts us.

Members: TBAG members must be 'local' enough to help with routine tasks for at least nine months of the year on an ongoing basis, and to participate in workshops or other programs.

Associates: Artists may also apply or be recommended to the group by existing members for associate TBAG membership. Associate members live in the greater area, and participate in group shows on an invitational basis in an ongoing way. However, due to distances or other restrictions, they are not able to regularly participate in TBAG programs or gallery staffing.

Guests: Artists may also apply or be recommended to the group by members for a specific group or solo show.

Relationship with Tecopa Hot Springs Resort. The Gallery doubles as the resort office, and mutual support is needed. When staffing the gallery, people should be able to handle resort reservations and check-in, as well as art sales and record-keeping. Training is available.

20% Commission. For all art sold as a result of being exhibited at the TBAG Gallery, a 20% commission must be paid to the gallery to help cover overhead costs.
